Aubrey was my guest last week at a mini concert I did for the Barbados alumni chapter (**Ken Khan** and **Gavin Ferreira** are the two activators there) of my high school alma mater, St. Stanislaus College. It's just plainly surprising that there were Guyanese living in Barbados for the past 15 years who had not even heard of Aubrey who has been a successful professional hotel circuit entertainer all that time; so you can understand how ignorant we are in the scattered diaspora.

Aubrey's voice is rich and mature, his guitar is dynamic, his lyrics and melodies are unique and they dare NOT to be stereotypical Caribbean calypso or reggae, and he is an on-stage personality. He sang just two of the songs from MOON, and after the show, all of the CD's he brought with him were snapped up by instant "blown away" fans.
